**Application for Amendment of M2017**

I refer to your letter of 10 October 2005 regarding Cement Australia's application to include an additional mining lease on environmental authority M2017.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is assessing the application to amend the environmental authority. The process to amend an environmental authority is set out in the Environmental Protection Act 1994 (EPAct) in Part 8 of Chapter 5. An assessment level decision has been made and requires the application to be assessed as a Level 1 Non Code Compliant application and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.

A draft environmental authority will be submitted to the Department of Natural Resources and Mines (DNRM) for public notification under section 254 of the EPAct. Section 251(4) states that an objection made under section 216 may only be made about an existing provision of the environmental authority only to the extent the provision is proposed to be amended under the application.

The application will be available for inspection by the public at the DNRM office in Rockhampton and the EPA Office in Gladstone when the public notice period starts.
